

Family Size Confirmation: Dependent Student 2025-26 Academic Year

Instructions: Complete the below chart for your family size according to the FAFSA definition.

Family Size includes the following:

- Yourself (the student)
- Your parents, even if you are not living with them. \circ Exclude a parent who has died or is not living in the household because of separation or divorce.
 - o Include a parent who is on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces apart from the family.
- Your siblings, if <u>all</u> the following are true:
 o They live with your parents (or live apart
 because of college enrollment),
 o They receive more than half of their support from your
 parents, AND
 - They will continue to receive more than half their support from your parents from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026
- Other persons if all the following are true:
 - They live with your parents,
 - They receive more than half of their support from your parents, AND
 - They will continue to receive more than half their support from your parents from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026

Note: The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other persons" align with the requirement that family size align with whom the parent could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the parent were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of completing the 2025-2026 FAFSA. As a result, parents should not include any unborn children in the family size.
